Duchen, Clare, Feminism in France from May 1968 to Mitterand [1], London, Routledge, 1986, pp. 165

Chapter 1, 'Beginnings' examines role of women in May 1968 and the emergence of the Mouvement de Liberation des Femmes in 1970, laying of a wreath on the tomb of the unknown soldier to commemorate his wife (leading to arrests), support for women strikers (e.g. in a hat factory in Troyes) and the <u>5th April 1971 Manifesto</u> [2] by 343 prominent women who had resorted to illegal abortions. Later chapters explore ideological divisions within the movement, theoretical issues and the relationship of feminists to socialist government in France.
