Young, Nigel J., [The Oxford International Encyclopedia of Peace](#) [1], New York, Oxford University Press, 2010, 4 volumes, pp. 2848

Although wide ranging in its theoretical approach to peace and in content, the Encyclopedia includes a strong focus on nonviolence, nonviolent action and groups and movements employing nonviolent methods.

Brock, Peter ; Young, Nigel J., [Pacifism in the Twentieth Century](#) [2], Syracuse NY, Syracuse University Press, 1999, pp. 434

(Revised and updated version of Peter Brock, *Twentieth Century Pacifism*, 1970, Van Nostrand Reinhold.) History of opposition to war drawing primarily on US and British experience, but including material on Gandhi and the later Gandhian movement, assessments of the position of conscientious objectors in many parts of the world, and references to transnational organizations, e.g. the War Resisters' International. Although the focus is on pacifism, the book includes material on the role of pacifists in the nuclear disarmament and anti-Vietnam War movements.

Year of Publication: 1987

Taylor, Richard ; Young, Nigel J., [Campaigns for Peace: British Peace Movements in the Twentieth Century](#) [3], Manchester, Manchester University Press, 1987, pp. 308

Collection of analytical and descriptive essays spanning period from late 19th century to 1980s, but the main focus is on post-World War Two movement against nuclear weapons. Michael Randle assesses '[Nonviolent direct action in the 1950s and 1960s](#)' [4], pp. 131-61.

Year of Publication: 1977

Young, Nigel J., [An Infantile Disorder? The Crisis and Decline of the New Left](#) [5], London, Routledge and Kegan Paul, 1977, pp. 490

The New Left became closely associated with opposition to the Vietnam War, and there are frequent references to this opposition in the US and UK, including a critique in chapter 9 'Vietnam and Alignment', of New Left support for North Vietnam, pp. 163-88.
