See especially 'Rights and resistance: The changing context of the dissident movement' (pp. 20-38); 'Pathways of labour insurgency' (pp. 41-61); and 'Environmental protest in rural China' (pp. 143-59) which includes reference to direct action against a factory polluting water. Second edition has added chapters on Falun Gong, Christianity and land struggles.
