

#SandtonShutdown: Hundreds of protesters march in Johannesburg to end gender-based violence

Although President Cyril Ramaphosa signed the Gender-Based Violence Declaration in April 2019, promising that the government would strengthen its fight against gender-based violence (GBV), which he called a national crisis, activists say that little has been done to tackle the issue.
