Aung reports on the protests that erupted in Nigeria on 2 October 2020, after a video circulated showing a man killed by police. She notes the role of two Afro-Pop musicians and feminists in promoting protests, and the rapid extension of demands to encompass misuse of public funds, the unemployment crisis. poor economic infrastructure and bad government.
