Analysis of lack of proper consultation and of legal protection for those evicted.

Mam, Somaly, [The Road of Lost Innocence: The True Story of a Cambodian Heroine](#) [3], New York, Random House Circle, 2009, pp. 224

Memoir by a Cambodian activist against sexual slavery, whose organizations have tried to rescue, shelter and teach girls and women escaping from sexual exploitation in Cambodia, Thailand, Laos, Vietnam and more generally. She received high level international support, but the credibility of her claims to have been sent to a brothel as a child, and of her most lurid examples of abuse in the sex industry, was challenged in a [Newsweek report, 21 May 2014](#) [4]. An interview and report in [Marie Claire 16 September 2014](#) [5] in turn queried some of the allegations and interpretations of the *Newsweek* story. Mam is still involved in campaigning and fund raising, but controversy continues about her role, management of her campaigns, and the extent of exploitation in the sex industry.

Schapiro, Jonathan Anjaria ; McFarlane, Colin, [Urban Navigations: Politics, Space and the City in South Asia](#) [6], London, Routledge, 2001, pp. 347

Focuses on conflicts over urban space, resources and housing in Cambodia, India, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka, and includes accounts of resistance in squatter settlements, e.g. in Kathmandu.

Schneider, Alison Elizabeth, [What Shall We Do without Land? Land Grabs and Resistance in Rural Cambodia](#) [7], Sussex University, International Conference on Global Land Grabbing, 6-8 April 2011, organized by Land Deals Politics Initiative with Journal of Peasant Studies, 2011

Covers three different types of land grab (one by military) and types of peasant resistance, from overt protests and petitions to 'everyday resistance' such as sleeping on threatened land and organizing road blocks.

Detailed analysis of the evolution of the US war on Cambodia.

In this interview Mary Robinson, former President of Ireland and UN Special Envoy on Climate Change, talks about the Mary Robinson Foundation-Climate Justice. She discusses how climate change disproportionately affects women, especially through undermining food security, and notes that many women are farmers in developing countries.
