The Nonviolent Action Research Project ran from 1994 to 1999, bringing together, activists, journalists and academics – and some who were two or three of these things at once – to reflect on issues in international politics and in particular on nonviolence and its contemporary relevance. The book ***Challenge to Nonviolence***, edited by **Michael Randle**, assembled 17 of these presentations and the subsequent group discussions.
